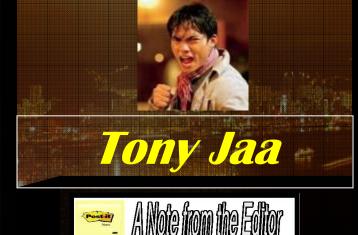

# **The Art of Eight Limbs**

Muay Thai is a form of hard martial art practiced in large parts of the world, including Thailand and other Southeast Asian countries. The art is similar to others in Southeast Asia such as: pradal serey in Cambodia, lethwei in Myanmar, tomoi in Malaysia and Lao boxing in Laos. Muay Thai has a long history in Thailand and is the country's national sport. Traditional Muay Thai practiced today varies significantly from the ancient art muay boran and uses kicks and punches in a ring with gloves similar to those used in Western boxing.

Muay Thai is referred to as "The Art of Eight Limbs", as the hands, shins, elbows, and knees are all used extensively in this art. A practitioner of Muay Thai ("*nak muay*") thus has the ability to execute strikes using eight "points of contact," as opposed to "two points" (fists) in Western boxing and "four points" (fists, feet) used in the primarily sport-oriented forms of martial arts. A practitioner of Muay Thai who is not of Thai nationality or race, is known as a Falang Nak Muay (foreign boxer).

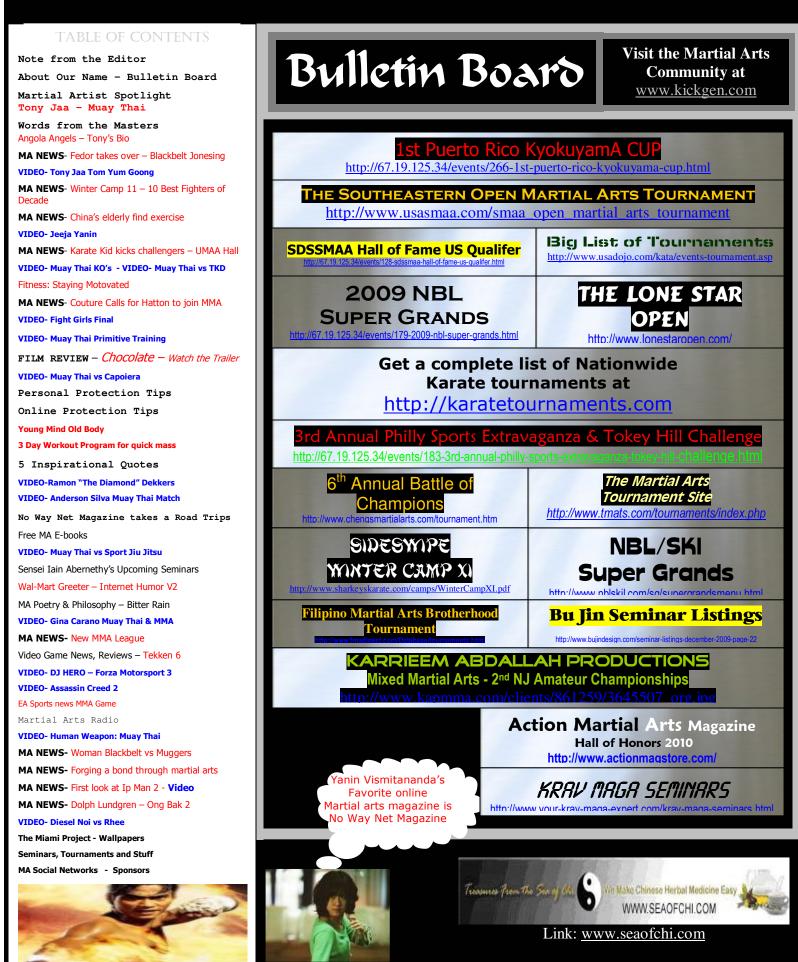

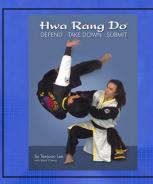

### Tony Jaa's Biography

Tatchakorn Yeerum or formerly Panom Yeerum born February 5, 1976 in Surin province, Isaan, Thailand), better known in the West as Tony Jaa, in Thailand as Jaa Panom is a Thai martial art film actor, choreographer and director. His films include Ong-Bak: Muay Thai Warrior, Tom-Yum-Goong (also called Warrior King or The Protector) and Ong-Bak 2: The Beginning.

Tony Jaa was raised in a rural area and as he grew up he watched films by Bruce Lee, Jackie Chan and Jet Li at temple fairs, which was his inspiration to learn martial arts. He was so inspired by them that while he was doing chores or playing with friends, he would imitate the martial arts moves that he had seen, practicing in his father's rice paddy. Also, he would give baths to the family's elephants and somersault off their backs into the river.

What they did was so beautiful, so heroic that I wanted to do it too," Jaa told *Time* in a 2004 interview. "I practiced until I could do the move exactly as I had seen the masters do it."<sup>[1]</sup>

At age 15 he requested to become a protégé of stuntman and action-film director Panna Rittikrai. Panna had instructed Jaa to attend Maha Sarakham College of Physical Education in Maha Sarakham Province

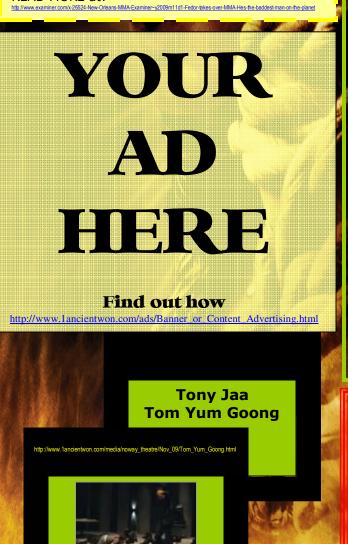


Fedor takes over MMA: "He's the baddest man on the planet"

BLACK BELT JONESING: AMERICAN MARTIAL ARTS CULTURE'S ROOTS IN THE BLACK COMMUNITY

For fans of the 1984 Pat Morita and Ralph Macchio blockbuster "The Karate Kid," the spy photos that leaked out of China last month were like a crane-kick to the heart.

The half-dozen blurry pics, snapped from the forest surrounding Hubei Province's Wu Tang Mountain, showed for the first time Jaden Smith, the young martial-arts loving son of box-office superstar Will Smith, in his role as "Dre," the protagonist of the film's forthcoming remake -- due in theaters next June. (Meanwhile, action icon Jackie Chan is waxing on as the story's wise but reluctant master.)

Online commenters were outraged by the images: Andrew Mack of the genre film fansite Twitch even linked to the shots with the headline "Hey Look! It's Jackie Chan and Jaden Smith Trouncing on My Childhood!" After all, they visually confirmed what fans had been hearing since September 2007 -- that their beloved martial-arts melodramedy was being "updated" for the 21st century with a wildly different script and cast.

And while most critics have sidestepped gingerly around the racial landmines embedded in their anxiety, some haven't been as careful: "Every remake these days, they change the main character to a black guy," groused commenter Kevin, over at the movie blog Cinematical. G.J. at E! Online was even more blunt "A 10-year-old black kid as Karate Kid? What a joke. I hope this kid gets scarred for life for doin.....

The nature of mixed martial arts dictates that stars come and go. Injuries, burnout, contract issues and illness make it so that few fighters can dominate for a long period of time. But there have been a few who have stayed at or near the top of the pile for the past decade. As part of Yahoo! Sports' look back at the past ten years in sports, here are the top ten mixed martial artists of the decade.

**10. Matt Hughes:** Though he's faded in recent years, Hughes was one of the UFC's most successful champs. His win over MMA pioneer Royce Gracie signaled a change of the guard, and he defended his welterweight belt eight times. Hughes also has wins over both B.J. Penn and Georges St. Pierre.

**9. Tito Ortiz:** The "Huntington Beach Bad Boy" ended the decade on a weird note, with a decision loss to Forrest Griffin. Before his exile from the UFC, Ortiz was the longest reigning UFC champ with wins over Wanderlei Silva, Vitor Belfort and a trilogy of wins over nemesis Ken Shamrock.

#### Karate kid kicking challengers to curb

Lyoto Machida is a mystery the rest of the <u>UFC</u> is trying to solve, without success thus far. Fifteen fighters have challenged Machida and his karatebased style of mixed martial arts. All of them have wound up beaten, including previously undefeated <u>Rashad Evans</u>.

Machida won the UFC's light heavyweight title from Evans last May and defends it for the first time tonight at UFC 104 at the Staples Center against Mauricio "Shogun" Rua, a former PRIDE star who thinks he can solve the riddle of "The Dragon."

"For most athletes that you face, you just need to train, adapt to little things but train as you regularly do because you're used to what they bring to the table," Rua said. "But Lyoto is a different guy with a karate background and well adapted to mixed martial arts. It's very tough to

Major figures from around the boxing world have urged Hatton to retire from boxing for his own safety - but he won't be rushed into a decision.

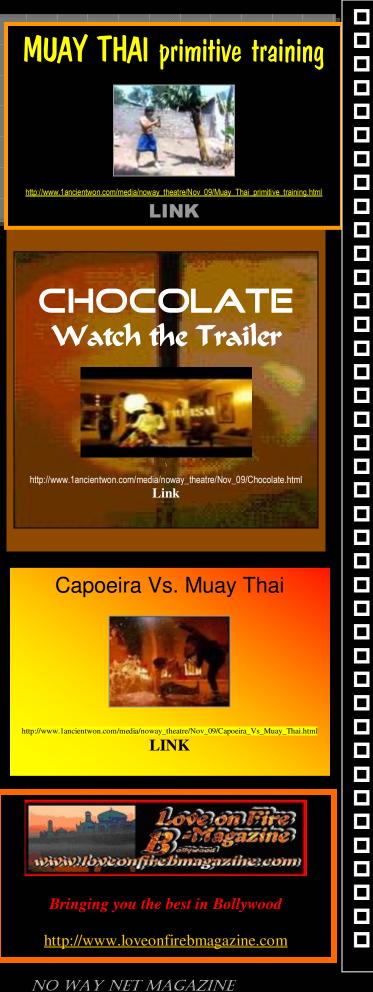

# Chocolate

With Thai cinema getting more international play I've become a fan of its vigourous enthusiasm and inventive stunt choreography, as well as the ever present cheeky humour which can snap into a pratfall in a eyeblink. I'm mightily entertained by the Thai's rapid semi-satirical cross-genre colonisation, that's resulted in movies like "The Eye" (Japanese style horror), "Bang Rajan" (Chinese like historical epic), and "SARS Wars" (Zombie comedy!)

Directed by Prachya Pinkaew this latest spiffing Thai action comedy begins with a Yakuza gangster, played by popular Japanese actor Hiroshi Abe, revealing that as a boy he was always interested in the abnormal. (Hiroshi is known to genre buffs for his role in "Godzilla 2000", as a voice actor in the anime "Fist of the North Star" and as the male lead in the science fiction film, "Sword of Alexander" aka "Taitei no Ken".)

Well, he finds plenty to interest him in Thailand, where his strange preferences lead him into a dangerous relationship with Zin, a beautiful Thai woman (played by Ammara Siripong) immersed in the hazardous world of Thailand's gang culture. When her Japanese lover is forced to leave the country Zin raises their autistic daughter, Zen, alone, but for the aid of a street urchin whom Zin adopts. The latter, a boy named Moom (artful dodgingly played by Taphon Phopwandee) has an entrepreneurial bent and craftily exploits the budding martial arts skills of his adopted sister, learned by watching Muay Thai kickboxing students and action movie DVDs.

Zen is played by Nicharee Vismistananda (also known as JeeJa Yanin) in her film debut. A taekwondo black belt, Jeeja trained for years with the film's.....

### Safety on the Streets

Choose busy streets and avoid passing vacant lots, and stick to well-lighted areas at night.

Do not walk or jog alone.

Get to know the neighborhoods where you live and work.

Carry your purse close to your body, and keep a firm grip on it. Carry a wallet in an inside coat pocket or front pants pocket.

Do not overload yourself with packages, and avoid wearing shoes or clothing that restrict your movements.

Carry a whistle or other sound device in case of an emergency.

If your car breaks down, raise the hood or tie a white cloth to the street-side door handle - stay in the locked car.

Always carry an emergency kit in your car.

When using buses or subways, only use well-lighted, busy stops.

Stay alert on buses or subways; do not doze or daydream.

Send the message that you are calm, confident and know where you are going.

Trust your instincts. If something or someone makes you uneasy, avoid the person or situation and leave as soon as possible.

Keep in mind locations of fire and police stations and public telephones. Remember which stores and restaurants stay open late.

Take the fastest route to and from schools, stores and friends' houses.

Do not display your cash or any other inviting targets such as pagers, cell phones, or expensive jewelry and clothing.

Have your car or house key in your hand before you reach the door.

Always have an emergency kit in your vehicle.

# I want to save photos and other personal documents on a removable media. What is the most suitable media for the job?

For optimum security, it is recommended that you save important files on several media. So, a student writing an essay should save their work on a rewriteable CD-ROM and, where possible, on another media such as a removable hard drive. USB memory sticks are fragile tools designed for transporting, not storing, files and don't offer the best storage conditions.

#### What is a "hijacker"? How can I protect myself from them?

Hijackers are spy software that change a browser's homepage and sometimes make it impossible to access certain sites. The best-know of these is CoolWebSearch, which is particularly difficult to get rid of because it modifies your computer's registry. These malicious codes exploit software flaws in order to infiltrate your computer. Update all your programs and use anti-spy software to avoid them.

#### How can I tell whether an email that seems to come from a bank or another institution isn't a fake message (phishing) aimed at extracting confidential information from me?

Firstly, no bank, Internet service provider or other online service provider will ask you to confirm your bank details or password by email! So delete any emails which ask for confidential information without even opening them. If you're unsure, don't click on links given in the message; instead go to the relevant service provider's site by typing out the URL address yourself and checking if such a procedure exists. Don't hesitate to email the service provider to check on the authenticity of the message.

# I've heard that the number of viruses for Linux is on the increase. What is the true extent of this threat?

For now, the number of viruses targeting users of Linux remains minimal with respect to threats to other software environments, but the authors of malcodes are increasingly targeting web servers, an area in which Linux heads the field. Discovered at the beginning of November, the Lupper virus exploits three flaws found in the software components of most Linux distributions for servers. They may be less of a target than others, but Linux users aren't completely free from attack!

# Are the cookies installed by some sites a risk to my PC? Should I delete them?

The majority of sites install cookies on an Internet user's computer in order to compile statistics, define visitor profiles, or to prevent having the Internet user from having to enter their password at every visit. But other, less scrupulous, sites can use cookies to display unwanted adverts or to act as spy software by making a record of web pages visited. You can delete these cookies with the help of your anti-spyware.

#### I don't yet have an antivirus installed on my computer. How will I know if it's infected with a virus?

Log on to Symantec's web site and launch an analysis of your computer. If the online analysis reveals the presence of a virus, check if the site has a tool to.....

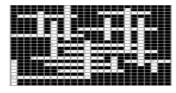

# Martial Arts Poetry & Philosophy



### Pointing the Finger to Zen

Often in Chinese martial arts, we are told the origins of the arts are also tied to Zen (Chan in Chinese). In my opinion, although Zen stems from traditional Buddhism, it is a system of liberation from a more religious, faith driven Buddhism, as might be other forms of Buddhism where chanting, rituals, mudras, mantras and sutras may seem more important than experiencing enlightenment for oneself. Zen is a vessel to cross over quickly, and for you to experience the awakened mind directly, as a result, Zen is more of an approach to realizing the mind, a philosophy, more than a religion. In many ways, high level mastery of a martial art is awakening and understanding, much like Zen is to Buddhism.

Often when we study Zen, we are presented with confusing stories, called koans (kung an in Chinese), and seated meditation. As I feel a student needs a roadmap to learning, and often finding a learned master is difficult, perhaps my few words here can be of use.

Although Zen is a teaching that must be realized outside normal transmission and points directly to the mind, for one to get a real understanding of Zen, one should at least have some background in three important sutras. The first of these is the Heart Sutra (Xin Jing in Chinese), also called the Prajna Paramita Sutra. It is very short, yet very profound. Basically the main point of this text is to explain the cross over from ignorance to wisdom. As the sutra says, "Form does not differ from emptiness; emptiness does not differ from form. Form itself is emptiness; emptiness itself is form. So too are feeling, cognition, formation, and consciousness." It is a direct pointing of the mind in an enlightened state. For the advanced martial artist, this profound statement gives us much to contemplate.

The second Sutra one should study is the Diamond Sutra (Jin Gang Jing in Chinese), also called the Vajra Prajna Paramita Sutra. The basis of the Diamond Sutra is the perception of opposites, seeing yin and yang and how it changes. It is said that the 6th patriarch inheritor, Hui Neng, came to enlightenment when he over heard a passage recited from the Diamond Sutra, " One should practice that thought which is nowhere attached". The sutra is of medium length and pretty simple to understand. When one perceives Yin and Yang, and finds oneself are stuck in between them, it is best to step away and perceive the middle way.

Although Bodhidharma (Ta Mo in Chinese) is considered the first patriarch and brought Zen to China, his teachings did not flourish until the time of.....

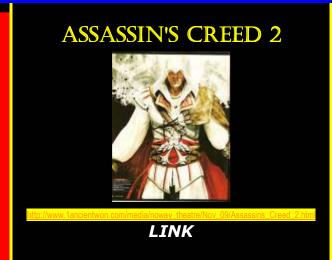

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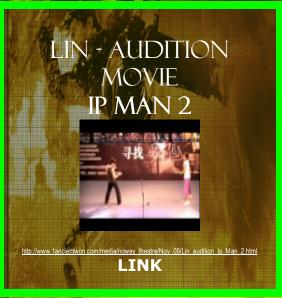

**Designed** novel experimental strategies including mild lowering of body temperature (hypothermia) to limit secondary damage following SCI. Promising effects with Interleukin-10, and the inactivation of NFkappaB are also under investigation.

**First** to demonstrate that adult human central nervous system neurons can regenerate when provided with a supportive cellular environment.

**Discovered** that the adult nervous system has a remarkable capacity to accept and integrate transplants of neuronal cell lines. Demonstrated that embryonic neurons can reconnect to muscle and restore its function in animals.

**Initiated** studies to explore whether neural precursor cells or stem cells can be developed and stimulated to mature into different types of nervous system cells.
